Subject: Urgent Concern – Resident in Critical Condition (Case 7)

Dear Authorities,

I am writing to bring to your immediate attention a deeply concerning situation regarding a resident of Wens foundation home, currently at Mater Dei Hospital (Out Patient).

Yesterday at approximately 7:05, individuals affiliated with us observed this disable resident, and it was immediately clear that he is severely underweight. The weight loss has been drastic and alarming. This is visibly evident, not only from his physical state but also from the clothing he was wearing—garments far too large for his current frame. In addition, we have been informed that he is suffering from a chest infection also.





We are conducting a thorough journalistic investigation with the sole aim of protecting and advocating for vulnerable individuals. We ask: why are the relevant authorities not acting to protect these persons? Why is there silence and inaction when these cases are brought forward?

We are volunteers. We are unpaid. We do this work because it matters—and yet we find ourselves doing the job that is the responsibility of those in positions of authority. This is not acceptable.

We urge you to verify this case directly with Mater Dei Hospital. You have access to the resident's medical records and can confirm whether he is improving or deteriorating.

Additionally, there was another resident of Wens Foundation reportedly admitted to Mater Dei yesterday. We are still working to gather concrete evidence on that case, but as always, we only send you verified and truthful information. Transparency is our only agenda.

"Please always let us know if anything we say is not true. We would be happy if these cases—and all the others we are investigating—turned out not to be real. But based on what we know, we cannot stay silent. We refuse to be complicit with those who see disabled persons only as numbers, not as human beings."

It is time to take real action before it is too late.
